
Dear Sirs:

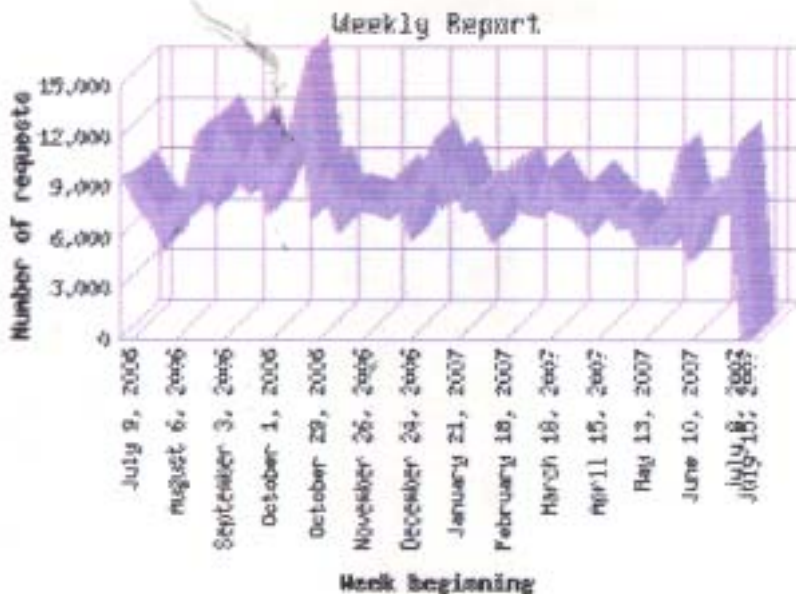
