Executive Committee & Board of Directors Meeting
July 19, 2009 – Veterans' Hall, Royer Park, Roseville, CA**

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING: The ASDSC Executive Committee meeting was called to order at 12:17 p.m. by President Christine Zell.

ATTENDEES: President – Christine Zell; Membership – Pat Wilcox; Webmaster – Morris Weisbart; Guests: Bonnie Abramson (Caller Procurement), Steve Riley (Youth), Carolyn Matthies (Historian), Keron Weisbart (Sunshine), Bob Kamuf, John Roloson and David Nilmeier. Treasurer Suzanne Cari and Harvest Hoedown Chairman Mitchell Cari had excused absences. The other elected positions on the Board of Directors are currently vacant.

MINUTES: President Zell reviewed changes to the May 17th minutes to include the identification of the new signers to the ASDSC bank accounts.

BOARD POSITIONS: President Zell announced that there were two volunteers to fill vacant positions on the Board and that she would request approval Bob Kamuf as Vice President and Bonnie Abramson as Secretary during the general meeting.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Christine Zell

STANDING RULES & BYLAWS: Recommended changes will go before the Board today. We will vote on Standing Rules immediately; Today will constitute the second reading of the recommended Bylaws changes, and then the vote will be taken.

PROFIT SHARING DANCE: We are looking for ideas to make this work but so far no real progress.

FIFTH SATURDAY DANCES: Not normally a profit maker, although we did make a slight profit in May. Should we continue with current format or make changes. Discussion followed, including the need to do more advertising to promote the dances and better coordination of what the responsibilities are for the hosting clubs. We will set up and distribute a schedule of next year's dances, club hosts and their responsibilities and distribute as soon as possible. Theme for the August dance is Luau.

PRESIDENTS' MEETING RE: CALENDAR: This meeting did not happen. President Zell will put together a calendar and send it out to all clubs asking them to coordinate a shift of dates if there are conflicts.

WEBSITE UPDATE: President Zell noted that the webmaster had updated all of the new dancer class information on the website. If clubs have not provided their information to Morrie they should do so immediately.

MEMBERSHIP LISTS: A reminder that all clubs need to submit a list of the dancers who graduated from class, along with the appropriate dues, as soon as possible. All clubs are asked to submit a complete club roster that includes all new dancers and any other members who may have paid their ASDSC dues with another club. Clubs are asked to submit those rosters as soon as possible. The Elk Grove Hoedowners are now officially the Diamond Dancers. They now dance at the Valley Oak Grange Hall, 347 5th & D Streets, Galt, CA, on Mondays from 7:15 to 9:15 p.m. Please update your listings.

There was extensive discussion about what activities the insurance covers. An insurance request should be submitted for all dance events, including fairs and demo dances, but that the dancers' insurance does NOT cover just a fair booth, fireworks stand, yard sale, campout or any other event that does not include dancing.

SECRETARY: Secretary pro-tem Christine Zell distributed the revised minutes from May 17th meeting; most of the corrections noted were typographical errors.

TREASURER: Suzanne Cari had an excused absence but had sent her reports and the budget. Unfortunately, most folks did not have their copies with them. The new checking account has been opened at Chase Bank and checks ordered. The taxes have been completed, but because we failed to claim the income and expenses for Harvest Hoedown and Fun Weekend for about three years we have to pay on these, plus a penalty that totals approximately \$3000. This will be addressed during the full meeting.

MEMBERSHIP: Pat Wilcox reported that she had received lists of new dancers and the accompanying dues payments from two clubs.

PROMOTIONS: President Zell announced that we would not be dancing at the State Fair this year, but that could change closer to the Fair. She also announced that Mitchell Cari wanted to run a newspaper ad campaign again this year. This will be brought up during the general meeting.

ADJOURNMENT: The Executive Committee meeting was adjourned at 12:55 p.m.

ASDSC BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING: The ASDSC Board of Directors meeting was called to order by President Zell at 1:04 p.m.

ATTENDANCE: Secretary Pro-Tem Bonnie Abramson called roll, with the following individuals present: John Roloson (Apple Jacks & Jills); Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows); Bill Hinson/George Fox (Capital City Squares – George arrived late, replacing Bill Hinson); Steve Riley (Elk Grove/Diamond Dancers/Youth Chairman); Carolyn Matthies (Free Spirits/Historian); David Nilmeier (Mavericks); John Zell (Overalls); Corky Bolin (Prime 8's); Don Herd (Starlite Shufflers); Ruth Moore (TNTs); Ed Combs (Whirl-A-Ways); and guests Bill Hinson, Bob Kamuf, Bonnie Abramson (Caller Procurement), Keron Weisbart (Sunshine) and Suzanne Herd. Officers in attendance included Christine Zell (President); Pat Wilcox (Membership) and Morrie Weisbart (Webmaster). Suzanne Cari (Treasurer) and Mitchell Cari (Harvest Hoedown Chairman) had an excused absence. All other elected positions are currently vacant. A quorum was declared with 11 clubs present.

BOARD APPOINTMENTS: President Zell requested approval of Bob Kamuf to serve as Vice President and Bonnie Abramson to serve as Secretary for the remainder of the year. Motion was made by John Zell (Overalls), seconded by Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows) to approve the appointments. Motion carried. We are still looking for people to serve in the position of Promotions Director and as a future chairman of Fun Weekend. If interested, please contact President Zell.

STANDING RULE CHANGES: President Zell reviewed the proposed Standing Rule changes. A motion was made by Corky Bolin (Prime 8's), seconded by Bill Hinson (Capital City Squares), to approve the Standing Rule changes as proposed. There was some off topic discussion relative to fees paid to callers and cuers hired by the Association and whether we are being fair to them. Caller Procurement Chairman Bonnie Abramson outlined the procedures used. After discussion the motion was carried.

BYLAWS: President Zell read the proposed changes to the Bylaws; this was the official second and final reading of the proposed changes. Motion was made by Ed Combs (Whirl-A-Ways), seconded by George Fox (Capital City Squares), to approve the Bylaws changes as read. Motion carried.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Christine Zell

PROFIT SHARING & FIFTH SATURDAY DANCES: We are looking for ideas to formulate a profit-sharing dance but so far no real progress. Fifth Saturday Dances are not normally a profit maker, although we did make a slight profit in May. Should we continue with current format or make changes, including a combination of local and out-of-area callers, reducing the number of rounds between tips and/or the level/number of levels offered during each dance. Discussion followed, including the need to do more advertising to promote the dances and better coordination of what the responsibilities are for the hosting clubs. We will set up and distribute a schedule of next year's dances, club hosts and their responsibilities and distribute as soon as possible. Theme for the August dance is Luau. Motion was made by Morris Weisbart (Webmaster), seconded by George Fox (Capital City Squares), to change the format of the August 29, 2009, dance to alternating Intro to Square Dance/Plus, with single rounds between tips. There will still be the 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Intro to Square Dance session followed by Pre-Rounds from 7:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Motion was carried.

Going back to the Profit-sharing dance idea, a motion was made by Morris Weisbart (Webmaster), seconded by Ruth Moore (TNTs), to do away with this idea. Motion carried.

TRAVELING CLUBS: President Zell asked the clubs to help get word out that we have a category for Travelling clubs in our Bylaws. This might help bring in dancers who might not otherwise belong to a club, or work for small clubs that are choosing to no longer meet on a regular basis.

INCORPORATION SCAM: Clubs were warned to be aware that are several scams currently being worked that ask organizations to pay a \$100 incorporation fee. Incorporation fees are only \$20 per year and paid through the Secretary of State's office.

WEBSITE UPDATE: President Zell noted that the webmaster had updated all of the new dancer class information on the website. If clubs have not provided their information to Morrie they should do so immediately.

PRESIDENTS' MEETING RE: CALENDAR: This meeting did not happen. President Zell will put together a calendar and send it out to all clubs asking them to coordinate a shift of dates if there are conflicts.

MEMBERSHIP LISTS: A reminder that all clubs need to submit a list of the dancers who graduated from class, along with the appropriate dues, as soon as possible. All clubs are asked to submit a complete club roster that includes all new dancers and any other members who may have paid their ASDSC dues with another club. Clubs are asked to submit those rosters as soon as possible.

BUDGET: The budget had been sent out by email, but most did not have it with them so it was passed around for review. This item will be put later on the agenda after everyone has had time to review it.

COUNCIL ADVANCE: President Zell requested a \$300 advance to attend the quarterly State Council meeting in Fremont. Motion was made by Corky Bolin (Prime 8's), seconded by Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows), to approve the advance. Discussion about sending Pat Wilcox to the Insurance Chairman's meeting, however she cannot attend so John Zell will attend in her place. Motion carried.

OFF-TOPIC DISCUSSION: Don Herd questioned why John Roloson was asked to resign. Long discussion, then President Zell was asked to address the issue privately with Don so that the meeting could proceed according to the agenda.

VICE PRESIDENT: Bob Kamuf

FIFTH SATURDAY DANCES: This issue was again addressed. May dance had good attendance and profit of \$46.05, mostly thanks to the extra effort by Ruth Moore to sell 50/50 tickets. Question on admission price for "intro" dancers. A motion was made by John Zell (Overalls), seconded by Don Herd (Starlite Shufflers), to make admission free for Intro/new dancers. Discussion covered making sure that the list of new dancer classes for all clubs be available at the dance (President Zell will be sure it is there), and to be sure that the Intro session will be noted in the newspaper ads being produced. Also some discussion on how callers are paid for these dances (flat fee). Motion carried.

FIFTH SATURDAY DANCE DUTIES: There was lengthy discussion on who has what responsibilities for each fifth Saturday dance, and what the hosting schedule is. It was decided that a list would be prepared and distributed to the clubs. *(Secretary's note: this list was prepared and distributed to each club shortly after the meeting. If your club did not receive a copy of this document please contact Vice President Kamuf.)*

SECRETARY: President Zell, in her role as Secretary Pro-tem for the May meeting, made note of the changes that were made to that meeting's minutes. Primarily, the minutes needed to show a list of the names designated to be signers on the ASDSC Checking account. Another correction noted was that "Steve" Hinson should actually have been "Bill" Hinson. John Roloson wanted a longer explanation noted in the minutes as to why a vote was taken regarding his presidency. A motion was made by Ruth Moore (TNTs), seconded by Corky Bolin (Prime 8's), to approve the minutes with only the addition of the list of signers on the checking account and the correction to Bill Hinson's name. Motion carried with two opposed.

TREASURER: Suzanne Cari was absent; President Zell read her written report.

ACCOUNT BALANCES/TAXES: Reported that our overall total for all accounts is \$72,729.02. The taxes have been completed and it has been determined that an error was made in the 2007/2008 taxes by not properly declaring all income and expenses (Harvest Hoedown, Fun Weekend and interest on the CDs were not included.) A motion was made by Don Herd (Starlite Shufflers), seconded by Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows), to pay all back taxes, penalties and accountant fees. Motion carried.

CHECKING & CD ACCOUNTS: The Association's checking account has been moved from Bank of America to Chase because BofA started charging fees on the account and Chase does not. Signature cards have been signed and checks ordered. Signers on the account are Treasurer Suzanne Cari, President Christine Zell, Webmaster Morris Weisbart, and Secretary/Caller Procurement Bonnie Abramson. Two signatures are required for every check. New CD accounts have been opened at Guaranty Bank. A motion was made by Corky Bolin (Prime 8's), seconded by John Zell (Overalls), to approve the Treasurer's report as submitted, subject to audit. Motion carried.

BUDGET: Attendees have had time to review the proposed budget for 2009. A motion was made by Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows), seconded by Corky Bolin (Prime 8's), to approve the budget as presented. Motion carried.

MEMBERSHIP: Pat Wilcox

NEW DANCER GRADUATES: Director Wilcox reported that she had received lists of new dancers and the accompanying dues payments from two clubs. She reminded other clubs to submit a list of the dancers who had graduated from class and to pay the appropriate ASDSC membership dues for them as soon as possible.

WHAT INSURANCE COVERS: President Zell reminded clubs what activities the insurance actually covers. An insurance request should be submitted for all dance events, including fairs and demo dances, but that the dancers' insurance does NOT cover just a fair booth, fireworks stand, yard sale, campout or any other event that does not include dancing. Separate insurance needs to be obtained by the clubs for coverage of these specialty events. In many cases, the county fair or event sponsor has access to low cost event coverage.

PROMOTIONS: Position vacant. President Zell reported.

STATE FAIR: As of now we have not been selected to dance at the State Fair. This could possibly change at a later date. *(Secretary's note: We were subsequently notified that we had been added to the program at the State Fair. Our dance time is 9:00 p.m. to 9:45 p.m. on the Promenade Stage on Tuesday, September 1st. Scot & Erin Byars will be calling and cueing. Square Dance attire is required. Dancers will be admitted to the fair FREE with square dance attire and club badge. Dancers wishing to participate should provide their Megan's Law information to President Zell as soon as possible – this information includes full name (first, middle, last), date of birth (month, date, year), driver's license number and state, and zip code where you live.)*

HARVEST HOEDOWN: Mitchell Cari, Chairman, was absent. President Zell read his written report (attached); Bob Kamuf gave a treasurer's report. Ads have been run in *Squarecaster*. Encouraged everyone to attend – this is our 50th Anniversary. Callers are Tony Oxendine, Bronc Wise and Andy Allemao; featured cuers are Rey & Sherry Garza.

WEBMASTER: Morris Weisbart submitted a written report (attached). There were 615 new visitors over the past five months, including a lot of interest in the new dancer class page. He also thought he had fixed all of the club contact e-mail links that were bouncing.

HISTORIAN: Carolyn Matthies.

CAMERA & RECORDER: President Zell reported that a new digital camera had been purchased as previously approved by the Board. She had added a case and insurance to protect the property from damage. In addition, a new digital recorder had been purchased for use by the Secretary. Total additional cost was \$475; she requested a motion to cover total payment. Motion was made by Corky Bolin (Prime 8's), seconded by Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows), to approve reimbursement for the additional costs. Motion carried.

INVENTORIES: Everyone was reminded that they need to provide a list to the Historian of any items you have in your possession that belongs to the Association. This list should include any of the yard or magnetic signs, decorations, hearing enhancement equipment, or other supplies in your possession. Please submit your list to Carolyn as soon as possible. Carolyn will email copies of the complete inventory list to President Zell and Secretary Abramson.

PHOTO ALBUMS: Carolyn will have the Association's historical scrapbooks up to date in time for display at Harvest Hoedown. All clubs are encouraged to add a page or two about your club's activities to the scrapbooks each year. See Carolyn for scrapbook pages or if you have any questions.

NATIONAL CONVENTION: Carolyn reported that the stage decorated by ASDSC for the National Convention in Long Beach turned out well and that she has pictures of that as well as many of our local dancers who were in attendance. Some discussion came up about what to do with the large photos that were used; one suggestion was to auction them off at a dance, while another suggestion was to use them to update our Association's showcase of ideas display and/or use them to add to decorations at Harvest Hoedown. The board will decide on what to do at a future meeting.

HARVEST HOEDOWN PHOTOS: Webmaster Weisbart has now added photos from the 2007 and 2008 Harvest Hoedown to our website and has turned the discs over to the Historian.

SUNSHINE/BLOOD RESERVE: Keron Weisbart

BLOOD RESERVE: Keron Weisbart passed out copies of the blood reserve designate forms to all clubs as most had not turned them in this year. Very important to have a designee from each club on record so that anyone from that club can access the account if needed.

SUNSHINE: Two members of the Mavericks, Don Reed and Diane Stout, have passed away. Cards were sent to their families, as well as to Mitchell Cari on the loss of his former Mother-in-Law (Laura's mother). Congratulatory card sent to Dick Howard and Joy Drinkwater on their marriage. Certificate presented to Goldancers on their 60th Anniversary. Please notify Keron if you have any events in your club that should be recognized.

FUN WEEKEND: Vacant. We are still looking for someone to Chair Fun Weekend in 2010. Scheduled dates are June 18 – 19, 2010 in Yuba City. Fairgrounds already reserved. Clubs should go back and discuss ideas on format they would like for the weekend. Concern over whether the games and other non-dancing activities are covered by our insurance; Pat Wilcox will research.

CALLER PROCUREMENT: Bonnie Abramson. Question regarding which dates we should hold dances in 2010. A motion was made by Morris Weisbart (Webmaster), seconded by Ruth Moore (TNTs), to not hold a dance in May of 2010 as it conflicts with Silver State in Reno. Motion carried. A motion was made by Morris Weisbart (Webmaster), seconded by George Fox (Capital City Squares), to not hold a dance on October 30, 2010. Discussion that this would be a perfect opportunity to encourage new dancers to attend a Halloween dance. It was noted that the clubs really need to do their share to support the dances, particularly when they are co-hosting, as lately all of the burden has fallen on a small few of the officers and it is not fair to them. Motion was defeated. There will be an Association dance on October 30, 2010.

YOUTH: Steve Riley reported he has collected over \$500 already this year for the State Council's Youth Scholarship Program. A dancer from one of his clubs, Steven Fraga, was this year's winner of a \$500 college scholarship. The youth and family hall at the National Convention was well received. Several youth dancers from Vacaville participated in the youth competition in Long Beach and did very well. Sunshine Chairwoman Keron Weisbart was asked to send a congratulatory card to Steven Fraga on behalf of the Association.

BYLAWS COMMITTEE: Since the Bylaws committee had completed their duties for the year President Zell thanked them for their service and disbanded the committee.

NEWSPAPER AD CAMPAIGN: President Zell reported that Mitchell Cari had proposed we spend \$5000 on a newspaper campaign promoting new dancer classes. There was a question about also doing radio but that was not being recommended at this time. Research was done on billboards and road signs, but both proved to be too expensive. John Roloson noted that several businesses in Placerville will put up signs for free; he is to provide President Zell with the appropriate contact information so that she can follow up. Recommended that clubs who have the magnetic or yard signs paste over the toll free number and put their own club contact information number on the signs. Once we pay for ads in the various newspapers, it is recommended we follow up by asking them to send out a photographer and/or reporter to come out and do a story – they are usually willing once you have paid for an ad. A motion was made by Ruth Moore (TNTs), seconded by Mike Barnes (Buttons & Bows), to allocate \$5000 from the Dancer Enhancement Fund for a newspaper advertising campaign. Motion carried with one opposed. John Roloson noted that his toll free number is still listed on the Association's website; Webmaster Weisbart will follow up.

OTHER ITEMS: The total number of annual dances and further discussion on 5th Saturday dances had already been covered.

TAXES: We have already covered the issue of taxes owed, but the Treasurer had wanted direction on where to draw the funds from. (The actual bill has already been paid, but she needs to know which accounts to charge.) A motion was made by _____, seconded by John Zell (Overalls), to determine what portion of the back taxes and fees were a result of the interest on the CDs and charge accordingly against the CD account, and all remaining charges would be applied to the Association's general fund. Some discussion for clarification. Motion carried with one opposed.

DEMO DANCES: John Roloson said there had been two demo dances approved by the Association – Scott Pearce had been paid for one but Claude Sipe had not been paid for the other. The reason – the bill had not yet been submitted to reimburse Claude. That bill has now been submitted and he will be paid. *(Secretary's note: this is a good reminder to all that if you have a bill that needs to be paid, or you are*

All other clubs were absent.

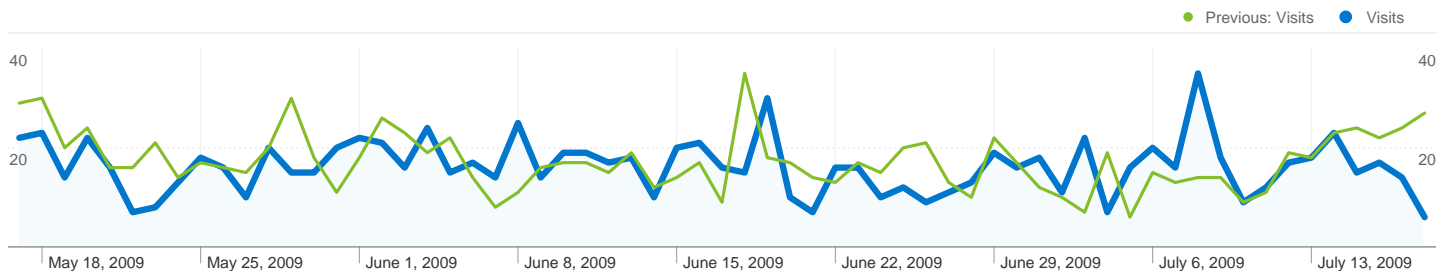

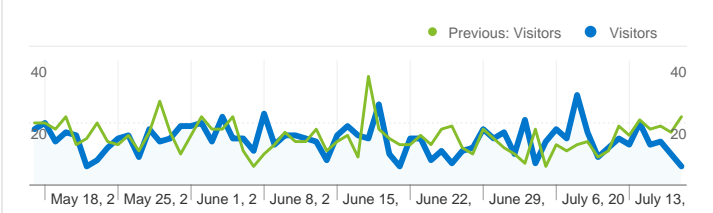

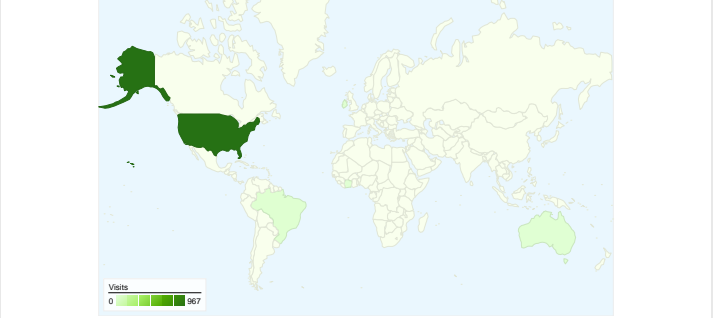

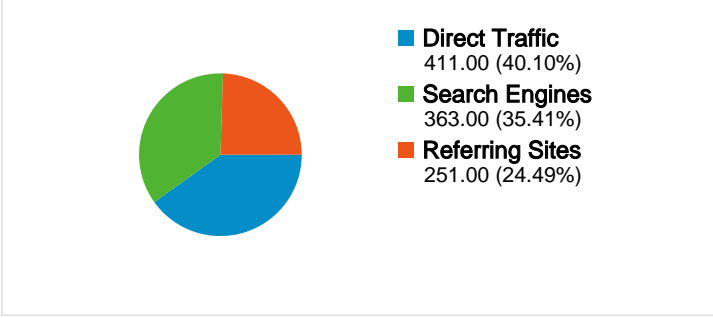
