Report covers November 20, 2005 meeting held at the Denny's Restaurant in Roseville.


The Callers Association and the River City Rugratz cosponsored a Mainstream dance on September 18th at the Orangevale Grange Hall it was sparsely attended. The October 5th dance had nine couples in the afternoon round dance session and about 5.5 squares in the evening.

Question asked on whether there has been any feedback on the New Dancer Program at Harvest Hoedown. Bryce reported he spent a great deal of time in the ND hall and had the impression that the callers had not been properly advised of the level in the hall. They adjusted on the fly and the dancers appeared to have a great time. There were a few complaints that the callers were calling things they had not yet been taught.

New officers for 2006 are President, Phil Smith; Vice President, Jim Diffey; Secretary, Lawrence Johnstone; and Treasurer, Joe Kula.

The 5th Saturday dances for 2006 are: April 29, July 29 and December 30.

Scot Byers report he had finished the first portion of the Teach the Teacher Program. The program is aimed at grades 3-5. It uses approximately calls 1-35, concentrating on calls using handholds, such as circles and stars, since these work better for young children. He is currently working on the second phase, for grades 6-8; the final phase will be targeted at high school and college. Scot gave Bonnie Abramson permission to present what he had developed so the CAPER, which is a statewide physical education conference. They sold about 50 copies. Erin had spoke to a few teacher who have used phase one and they have said it worked wonderfully.
