Harvest Hoedown is a weekend square dance festival sponsored by the Associated Square Dancers of Superior California. While this event is open to the public, the primary attendees will be square and round dancers from throughout California and Northern Nevada, who are there to participate in the “learned” square dance program. Approximately 400 people attend this 3-day event each year, including many who camp in RVs on the fairgrounds.

Rental fee for each 10' x 10' booth is **\$80.00**.

A minimum deposit of \$40 per booth requested must accompany your Vendor Application Form; Balance of rental fee will be due no later than 6:00 p.m. on opening day of the festival or prior to commencement of your booth set-up.

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DATES: October 26, 27, 28, 2012

LOCATION: Yuba-Sutter Fairgrounds, 442 Franklin Avenue, Yuba City, California

CONDITIONS: This is a square dancing weekend for dancers of all ages, including youth. Many of our dancers will be staying in their RVs on the Fairgrounds.

DANCE SCHEDULE HOURS: Friday, October 26, 2012 - 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Saturday, October 27, 2012 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. & 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Sunday, October 28, 2012 - 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The vendor hall will be closed on Saturday from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. for a dinner break. The hall will be re-opened at 6:30 p.m. for line-up for pre-dance shopping and set-up for the "Riot Dance" and Welcome Ceremonies.

SET-UP: The Fairgrounds will be available for set-up Thursday, October 25, 2012. Vendors are welcome to open for business beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, however vendors are not required to be open until 6:00 p.m. on Friday.

TEAR-DOWN: No vendor is allowed to tear-down until after 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 28, 2012. Load-out must be complete by 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 28, 2012.

RENTAL FEES: Rental fee for each booth is **\$80.00**. A deposit equal to 50% of total booth rental for spaces requested is due with your vendor application. Balance of rental fee will be due no later than 6:00 p.m. on opening day of the festival or prior to commencement of your booth set-up. Each vendor is limited to six (6) spaces.

RV PARKING/FOOD: There is RV parking available on the fairgrounds. Complete the RV parking portion of a standard Harvest Hoedown registration form to request space for your RV and/or any additional supply trailers. Parking for vendor RVs and supply trailers will be as close to the exhibit hall as possible, unless individual vendor requests to be parked with another group. There will be a food concession stand open in the exhibit hall beginning with dinner on Friday evening and remaining open through lunch on Sunday. In addition, there will be a barbeque dinner on Saturday evening; tickets for the barbeque dinner may be purchased in advance on the registration form.

EMERGENCIES. Driveways must be available to the fork lifts entering the building.

LIABILITY: ASDSC, the Harvest Hoedown Committee, and the Yuba-Sutter Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any injuries that may occur to vendor or vendor's employees, or for any loss or damages to product and/or equipment that may accrue whatsoever while in transit to or from the event, during loading and unloading or throughout the duration of the event. In addition, Vendor agrees to hold harmless and defend at its own expense ASDSC, the Harvest Hoedown Committee, and the Yuba-Sutter Fairgrounds from and against any suits, liabilities or claims for damages or injuries sustained by any person arising out of Vendor's use of space or spaces in connection with the event. The Association, Committee, or Fairgrounds assume no responsibility for theft, loss, damage or acts of God.

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
