

CURRENT ASDSC DISTRICT ASSIGNMENTS Recommended Changes for 2005

In January the ASDSC Board of Directors began an overall review of the Association's Bylaws, Standing Rules and Guidelines. As part of that review, the Bylaws Review Committee has recommended a restructuring of the Club District Assignments to coincide with the reduced number of clubs currently holding membership in the Association. The ASDSC Board of Directors approved the following recommendations at their meeting on March 13, 2005. The revisions will become effective at the end of the ASDSC Delegates' meeting on April 10, 2005.

By following the recommendations below we would balance out the districts a little better with a minimum number of changes. It is further recommended that District #10 be re-numbered as District #1 and leave all the other numbered districts the same to avoid confusion. These recommended changes would reduce the number of districts from 11 to 8.

If a Club has questions regarding the reasons for the recommended changes, a representative should contact ASDSC Membership Director Ruby Trinidad to discuss their concerns. Per Article XII, Section 1d and e, if any club does not agree with the proposed redistricting assignments they must come to the next regularly scheduled Board meeting to address their concerns to the Board. All questions or concerns must reach Ruby no later than Saturday, April 9, 2005. Finalization of the changes will take place at the April 10, 2005 ASDSC Board meeting.

Comments in *ITALICS* represent the proposed changes.

- District #1 – Round Dance Clubs ... no current members. *Recommend deleting this district with the understanding that any round dance clubs who join the association in the future will be assigned to the district closest to their geographic area. Recommend re-numbering District #10 (Placerville Area Clubs) to District #1.*
- District #2 – Orangevale/Fair Oaks/Folsom Area ... Patchwork Squares; Starlite Shufflers; Overall
- District #3 – Hwy 50/Rancho Cordova Area ... Sundowners; Free Spirits; Suburban 8's
- District #4 – North Sacramento/Citrus Heights Area ... Guys & Dolls; Sacramento Single Squares; Square Generations
- District #5 – Downtown Sacramento/Elk Grove Area ... Capital City Squares; Elk Grove Hoedowners; Paws & Taws; Prime 8's; River City Rugrats ... *Recommend moving Paws & Taws to District #6.*
- District #6 – Yuba City/Marysville Area ... Good Vibrations; *Recommend Adding Woodland/Davis into this District and moving Paws & Taws into District #6.*
- District #7 – Roseville Area ... Mavericks; TNT's; Whirl-A-Ways
- District #8 – Grass Valley Area ... Goldancers ... *Recommend combining Districts #8 & #9 into one District*
- District #9 – Auburn Area ... Buttons & Bows ... *Recommend combining Districts #8 & #9 into one District and eliminating District #9.*
- District #10 – Placerville Area ... Apple Jacks & Jills; Mainstreet Strollers; Sierra Squares. *Recommend re-numbering this to District #1 and eliminating District #10.*
- District #11 – Country Western Clubs – now defunct. *Recommend eliminating District #11.*
